AS ONE DOOR CLOSSES GOD WILL OPEN ANOTHER

It was almost exactly forty-four years ago in very early 1975 that with construction work completed our current building was handed over for the inaugural worship service. Now the building is to be replaced having been our spiritual home for some three years longer than the first wooden hall where the Broadstone Evangelical Free Church fellowship met from 1933 to the mid-seventies.

So here we are some eighty-six years later, and a new chapter is about to begin. Just over ten years ago the diaconate met and decided to plan for future growth, have a larger building designed and set about in faith raising the necessary funds.



With the first part of the project completed and in use by early 2015 attention turned to the worship hall itself and now the key moment has arrived when we hand over the plot and the keys to the builders to complete our vision.

January the 13th 2020 is the start date for the eleven months of work to begin and we must be patient and maintain the unity in Christ we have as we wait for completion.
