## **We are relocating - but only temporarily!**

It was with a mixture of emotions that we held our final services last Sunday in our long serving Marley style, pre-fabricated concrete building before it is replaced.

Many hundreds of men, women and children have passed through the doors for worship, prayer, baptism, marriage, mission meetings and gatherings of all kinds.

However, this is only a temporary relocation, only for morning worship services and our new short-term home is very close at hand. Evening worship services will be held in the lower hall of the Phase One Community Building at the usual 6.30-7.30 pm time unless notified otherwise.

*If you are not familiar with the location of the school which has one-way roads on three sides please see the map below which also shows the entrance to the school car park on Tudor Road.*

**Please Note:-** The school do not permit stiletto heels of any type to be worn in the school hall, as they cause floor damage. Please take note particularly if you are bringing visitors.

**Parking:-** Please be aware that there is no guaranteed parking for those with limited mobility so drop off anyone in this situation as close as possible to the entrance and then park your car in the playground. All cars need to be parked in the main car park/playground but please try to leave the spaces nearest the school for those who need them most. The Car Park team will help you.

We are privileged to be able to gather together freely to worship our God on Sundays. Arriving in good time is one way to acknowledge that we are expecting to meet with the living God and will allow you to have time to settle your thoughts and your heart before the service starts.

Sunday morning services will start promptly at 10:30 as normal. If you are driving, bear in mind that a one-way system operates in Station Approach, Moor Road and Tudor Road. Please arrive in good time and park where the car park team ask you to. If you need to drop someone off, please take care not to block access for anyone else.

Entrance to the school is via the main front door.

Sunday school and Bible Class will take place as normal during the service and there will be tea and coffee after the service.
