Adieu Open Plan & Au Revoir Breeze Blocks

Great news! The team from South Coast Windows in Poole arrived back on Friday to complete the work that they started earlier in the week and we are very happy to report that, by close of play on Friday, the church is fully glazed and watertight! We now have high and lower level windows, lockable front doors and a pair of fire exit doors at either end of the worship hall. The windows are all manufactured in aluminium, powder coated white and fitted with sealed double glazed units. The glazing units feature high specification Pilkington "K", heat retentive glass, with a 28mm air break between panes. At the front, below the architectural waistline, the doors and glazed units are presented in a soft looking satin aluminium, rather than white. The crisp white window frames look stunning against the beautiful bathstone blocks.



Au Revoir BBs :- There is no doubt that the advent of the breeze-block brought huge speed and cost advantages to the building industry. However, aesthetically they are rather challenging so we won't shed many tears as we bid farewell to the bumpy dark grey finish and welcome in the smooth freshly applied plaster. Now that it's been plastered, that massive rear wall looks like it's crying out for some skilfully positioned handholds and foot grips, to give ourselves a wonderful climbing wall that could rival the "Rock-Reef" indoor activity centre at the end of Bournemouth Pier.
