

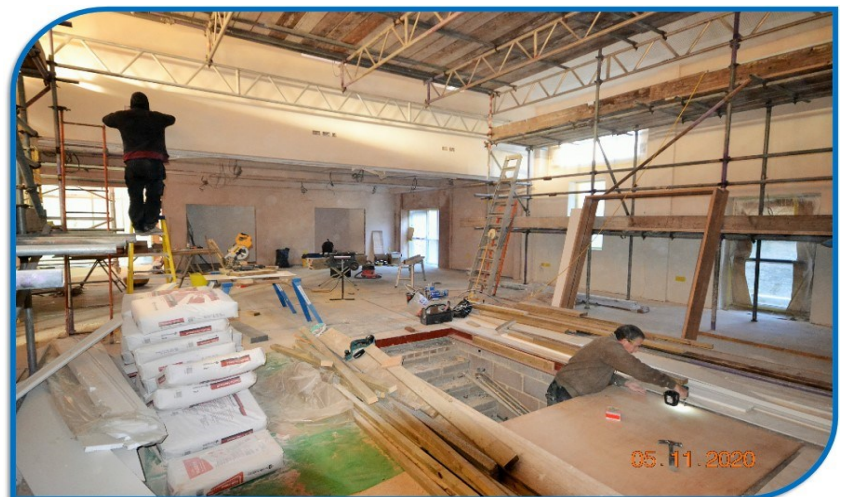

Earlier this week we bade a grateful farewell to the skilled team from Tony Merrick plasterers in Swanage. Now, as you enter the building, you get the fragrances (if that's the right word) of paint and flooring adhesive - it all points to the fact that the finishing phase is well and truly underway and we can all rejoice in that. Decorative Services UK, who have their regional offices in Poole, have been contracted by Matrod Frampton to complete all the internal walls and ceilings painting. With such large areas to cover, brushes and rollers would take for ever, so they are using airless spray-painting equipment to apply the mist and topcoats. Right:- The smaller of the two meeting rooms gets another coat of apricot white emulsion and our photograph lower left, shows another coat of pure white being applied to the acoustic panels that make up the vast ceiling space. Another contractor new to the site is locally based "Living Floors", who will be responsible for all the "walk-on" surfaces. We now have tough, non-slip vinyl floors laid in each of the three large storage cupboards off the main worship hall. Very good they look too!
