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A BREAK-OUT OF (V. IMPORTANT!) YELLOW SPOTS

It's Thursday the 6th of February and as promised next at our freshly levelled site are the engineers from Baypoint Surveys in Bournemouth. They have been tasked with marking all the key points (corners and edges) of the new worship hall. Luke and Elliot who were on site in November to position the front left-hand corner are now back to map out the entire plan.



So, as you can see in the picture below there are a lot of yellow headed marker stakes driven into the ground which we have circled in white to highlight their positions. As you know our new worship hall has, unlike a domestic property has very few inner walls therefore the marking out is relatively simple. Each of the mini plastic yellow domes carries a uniquely numbered "F" reference code which of course cross references to the architect's drawings. The one-dimensional master plan in underway!



Gone are the days of theodolites, ranging rods and basic hand signals. Baypoint use the latest sophisticated Trimble S6 robotic total stations (the device on the tripod) and then apply coordinates in conjunction with local existing topographical surveys. They are accurate to 1mm over 30 metres!
