## Pastors Challenge for 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of 2020

Pastor Tim Gamston's sermon last Sunday morning was entitled "Praying for 2020 Vision" from Ephesians 1 verses 15-23.



During the sermon which is available to listen to from the "Sermons" page Tim challenged us to commit to memory Paul's prayer from verse 17 to 19a as shown below in bold. In fact its only seven words longer than "The Lord's Prayer" so the challenge is not as daunting as you might think.

### Ephesians 1 – Thanksgiving and prayer

<sup>15</sup> For this reason, because I have heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love toward all the saints, <sup>16</sup> I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers,

That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him, having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints, and what is the immeasurable greatness of his power toward us who believe.
